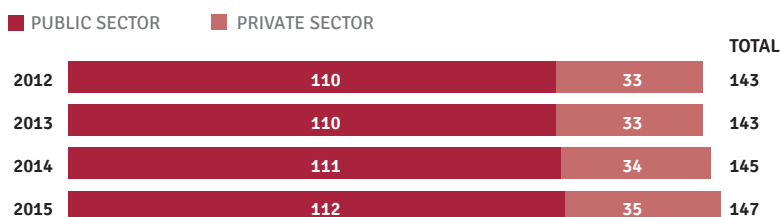

GLOSSARY

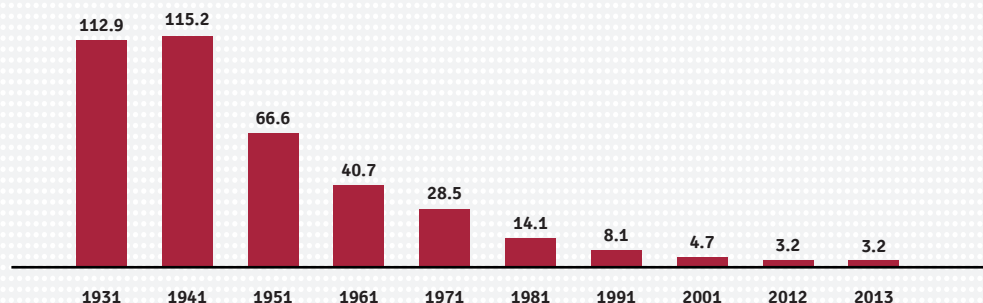
GENERAL PRACTITIONERS: the contract for general practitioners set a maximum limit of 1,500 patients each.

PUBLIC SECTOR HEALTH EXPENDITURE: the current operations carried out by the public administrations directly using their production facilities or buying goods and services from private institutions to be granted to citizens under specific agreements (including costs for administrative services, interests, taxes and fees, insurance premiums and contributions).

PRIVATE SECTOR HEALTH CARE EXPENDITURE: expenditure incurred by households and/or private insurances for the acquisition of healthcare services of any kind.

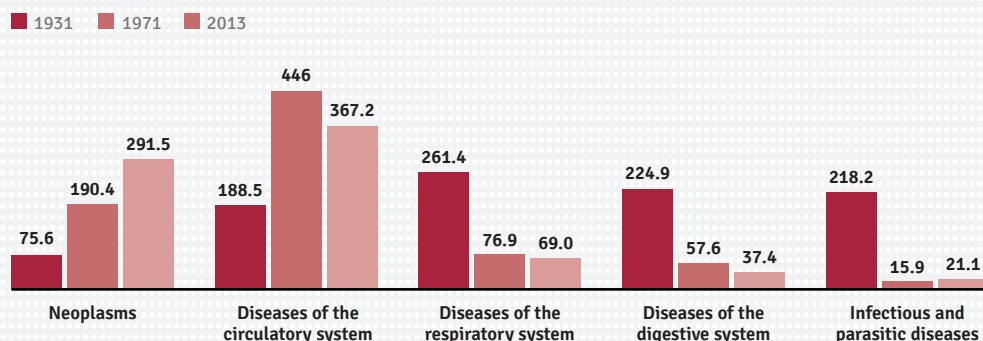
INFANT MORTALITY

Years 1931-2013, per 1,000 live births



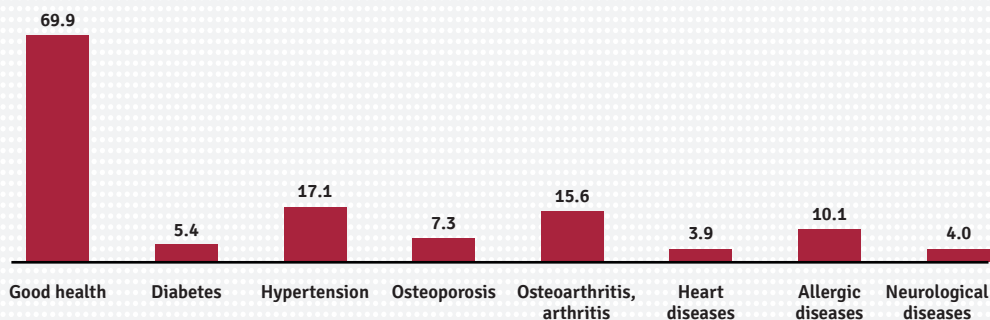
DEATHS BY SOME CAUSES

Year 2015, per 100 persons



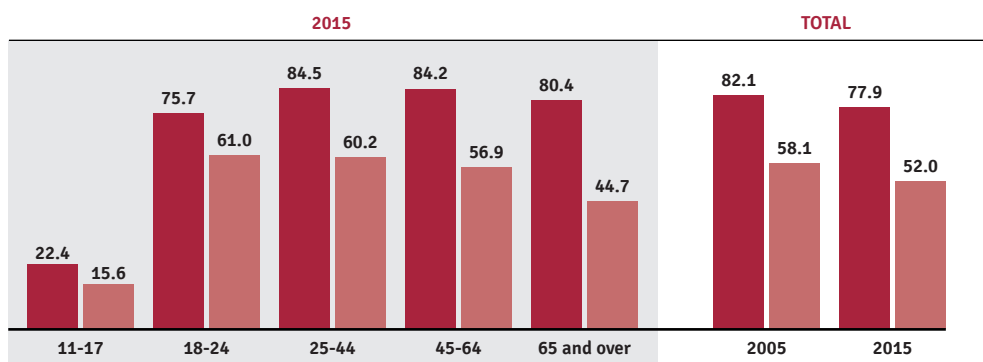
GLOSSARY
