

Export of Italian Regions

Third quarter 2017

Istat presents the breakdown of national exports by Italian Regions¹ for the reference period January-September 2017.

In the third quarter of 2017, compared with the previous period, in seasonally-adjusted terms, exports increased for *North-East* (+3.0%), *South and Islands* (+1.4%), *North-West* (+0.9%) and *Centre* (+0.7%).

In the first nine months of 2017, compared with the year earlier, exports increased for² *Islands* (+33.8%), *Centre* (+8.2%), *North-West* (+8.0%), *North-East* (+5.5%) while fell for *South* (-0.1%).

In the same period more relevant increases, according to their contribution to total export increment, are recorded for Lombardia (+7.3%), Piemonte (+8.9%), Lazio (+17.7), Emilia-Romagna (+5.8%) and Veneto (+5.1%), while relevant decreases were recorded for Basilicata (-16.4%) and Molise (-30.4%).
