

## Export of Italian Regions

Fourth quarter 2017

Istat presents the breakdown of national exports by Italian Regions<sup>1</sup> for the reference period January-December 2017.

In the fourth quarter of 2017, compared with the previous period, in seasonally-adjusted terms, exports increased for *South and Islands* (+8.2%), *North-East* (+5.7%), *North-West* (+1.7%) and *Centre* (+0.4%).

In 2017, compared with the year earlier, exports increased for<sup>2</sup> *Islands* (+29.4%), *North-West* (+7.6%), *Centre* (+7.0%), *North-East* (+6.6%) and *South* (+2.8%).

In the same period more relevant increases, according to their contribution to total export increment, are recorded for Lombardia (+7.5%), Emilia-Romagna (+6.7%), Piemonte (+7.7%), Lazio (+17.2%) and Veneto (+5.1%), while decreases were recorded for Basilicata (-13.3%), Marche (-2.0%) and Molise (-23.9%).
