

# Consumer price indices: provisional data

## December 2011

The Consumer Price Index measures the change in prices over time of a set of goods and services (CPI basket) representative of Italian household consumption.

### Istat estimates that in December 2011:

- the National Consumer Price Index for the whole nation **CPI** (see Italian **NIC**) used to measure inflation over the entire Italian economic system rose by 0.4% compared to the previous month and by 3.3% in comparison to the same month of the previous year;
- the EU Harmonized Index of Consumer Prices **HICP** (see Italian **IPCA**) developed to facilitate the comparison of inflation between Member States rose by 0.3% compared to the previous month and rose by 3.7% in comparison to the same month of the previous year.
