



(i) GLOSSARY

DISABILITY, OLD AGE, LENGTH OF SERVICE AND SURVIVORS' PENSIONS: paid in case of impaired work abilities; due to age limits or at the end of a full insurance career; to survivors in case of death of the pensioner or insured person provided that all insurance and contribution requirements are met.

COMPENSATORY PENSIONS: indemnities paid by reason of impairment or death (to survivors in this case) caused by an event occurred on the job.

SOCIAL ASSISTANCE PENSIONS: include non-contributory pensions, social allowances, pensions for the blind and partially-sighted, for the deaf and the invalid and war.

RETIREMENT RATE: per cent ratio of pensions to resident population on 31 December of the reference year.

RELATIVE BENEFIT INDEX: per cent ratio of average amount of pension to Gdp per inhabitant.
