

HOUSEHOLD BUDGET SURVEY: it was completely renewed in 2014. As deep changes have been introduced in every stage of the process, time comparisons can be only made by using reconstructed data and not previously disseminated data.


AVERAGE MONTHLY EXPENDITURE: average consumption expenditure incurred by resident households each month. It is calculated by dividing the total expenditure by the number of resident households in Italy.

AVERAGE ACTUAL EXPENDITURE: it is calculated by dividing the households' total expenditure for a good (or service) by the number of households that have purchased the same good (or service).

REFERENCE PERSON (R.P.): the family head as recorded in the Register Office.


# **TECHNOLOGICAL GOODS OWNED BY HOUSEHOLDS**
