

## Consumer price indices: provisional data

December 2010

The Consumer Price Index measures the change in prices over time of a set of goods and services (CPI basket) representative of Italian household consumption.

Istat estimates that in December 2010:

- the National Consumer Price Index for the whole nation **CPI** (see Italian **NIC**) – used to measure inflation over the entire Italian economic system – rose by 0.4 compared to the previous month and by 1.9% in comparison to the same month of the previous year;
- the EU Harmonized Index of Consumer Prices **HICP** (see Italian **IPCA**) – developed to facilitate the comparison of inflation between Member States – rose by 0.3% compared to the previous month and by 2.0% in comparison to the same month of the previous year.

HICP (base 2005=100)	112.1	+0.3	+2.0
