

Industrial production

May 2011

The index measures the monthly evolution of the volume of industrial production (excluding construction). Since January 2009 the indices have been calculated with reference to the base year 2005 using the new Ateco 2007 classification (Italian edition of Nace Rev. 2).

In May 2011 the industrial production index seasonally adjusted decreased by 0.6% compared with the previous month. The percentage change of the average of the last three months with respect to the previous three months increased by 1.6.

The calendar adjusted industrial production index increased by 1.8% compared with May 2010 (calendar working days being 22 versus 21 days in May 2010); in the period January-May 2011 the percentage change was +2.4 compared with the same period of 2010.

The unadjusted index of industrial production increased by 4.9% compared with May 2010. Indices of industrial production (a). May 2011 (b)
