

## Foreign Trade

### Export of Italian regions

#### January-September 2013

Istat presents the breakdown of national exports by Italian Regions<sup>1</sup> for the reference period July- September 2013.

In the third quarter 2013, compared with the previous period April – June 2013, in seasonally-adjusted terms, exports increase for *North-West* (+3.7%), *North-East* (+1.0%) and *South and Islands* (+0.8%) while decrease for *Centre* (-0.3%).

In the first nine months of 2013, compared with the same period of the previous year, exports increase for<sup>2</sup> *North-West* (+0.3%), *North-East* (+1.8%) and *Centre* (+0.2%) decrease for *South* (-6.1%) and *Islands* (-14.3%).

In the first nine months of the year, compared with the first nine months of 2012, more relevant decreases, according to their contribution to total export decrement, were recorded for *Sicilia* (-14.9%), *Puglia* (-15.8%), *Toscana* (-2.7%), *Sardegna* (-13.1%) and *Liguria* (-7.1%), while relevant increase are recorded for *Marche* (+12.7%), *Piemonte* (+2.9%), *Veneto* and *Emilia-Romagna* (+2.0% for both).
