

Contractual wages and salaries

July 2014

The index of wages according to collective labour agreements measures the evolution of contractual wages (per employee or per hour) set by collective agreements; the indices are calculated with reference to the fixed employment structure of the base period (December 2010).

At the end of July 2014 the coverage rate for the whole economy (share of national collective agreements in force) was 41.0 per cent in terms of employees and 38.9 per cent in terms of the total amount of wages.

In July 2014 the hourly index was unchanged and the per employee index increased by 0.1 per cent from last month.

Compared with July 2013 the hourly index increased by 1.1 per cent while the per employee index rose by 1.2 per cent. Both indices increased by 1.3 per cent comparing January-July 2014 with the same period a year earlier.
