 Turnover is measured in the annual business survey, as part of Structural business statistics, SBS.


 Administrative data for all enterprises in combination with survey data for a large sample

O Classification issues, especially with streaming services






Turnover, SEK millions (10 SEK/Euro)


Share of turnover by sizeclass
