635 cars

I have to be careful*

- ▶ not to distract myself (**16.0%**)
- ▶ to respect traffic lights and precedence rules (**14.5%**)
- ▶ not to exceed the speed limits (**10.3%**)

* first three ascertained or presumed causes of a road accident

55.8 victims per million inhabitants, Italy 18th in Europe (Eu28 average: 49.7)

17,309 serious injuries

5.1 serious injured for each death

Road accidents resulting in death or injury are a high social cost too

19.3 billion of euros spent in 2017 (1.1% of GDP)

I want to contribute to halve within 2020 victims in road accidents compared to 2010

annual percentage change 2010-2017: **-2.8%**

annual reduction required 2018-2020: **-15%**
