





## ISLP Poster Competition - Teacher's notes

## Goal of the competition

To improve students' abilities in describing their environment with help of statistics and in using statistics as a tool for learning about their lives on a daily basis.

## Why a poster?

Taking part in this poster competition will encourage students

- to work as a team
- to investigate real questions using data
- to use their mathematical and graphical skills
- to interpret statistical results
- to develop written communication skills

## **Participants**

The competition is open to teams of 2–5 students (we do not allow posters made by only one student).

There are three divisions:

- students born in 2002 and younger
- students born in 1999 and younger
- undergraduate students in university (no age limit)

Teams are registered by teachers.

The theme of the poster is free.

Phases of the competition after registration by teachers with Country Coordinators (islp2018@istat.it) by 14<sup>th</sup> December 2018:

- 1. School competition
  - preparing posters
  - judging posters
  - submitting the best poster of each age category by **18**<sup>th</sup> **January 2019** to Country Coordinators (<u>islp2018@istat.it</u>)

    (only one poster per category)
- 2. National competition
  - posters will be judged by the National organizing committee
  - the winning posters will be notified to ISLP by **15**<sup>th</sup> **March 2019**







- the best posters from each country will represent their country in the international phase of the ISLP competition

#### 3. International competition

- winning national posters will be judged in an international final
- will be displayed at the 62<sup>nd</sup> World Statistics Congress of the International Statistics Institute in Kuala Lumpur, 18-23 August 2019
- international winners will be announced during this conference
- international winners will also be announced on the ISLP website
