People up to 15 years (8.6 million) are never married by law

Almost 60% of never married people aged 16 and over live in couple

aged 25-34
65% of women
81% of men.
They were 29% of women and 48% of men at Census 1991

DIVORCED
aged 55-64
6% of women
5% of men.
They were both 1% at Census 1991

MARRIED WOMEN
aged 65 and over (48%)
have overtaken
WIDOWED WOMEN (42%).
Married women were 37% and widowed women were 51% at Census 1991
