Abstract

- GGP provides high-quality data for scientific research on population dynamics and family changes
- Second round (GGS-II) started in 2020.
- The PNRR project "Fostering Open Science in Social Science Research" (FOSSR) supports GGS-II in Italy.
- The first wave in autumn 2024, aiming to interview 12,500 individuals aged 18-59 years, with 5,000 through CAWI and 7,500 through CAPI.
- The GGS-II results will provide up-to-date longitudinal data on family and reproductive dynamics from 2024 onwards.
- Data will follow the FAIR/O criteria.

Key Objectives

Updated longitudinal, internationally comparable data on:

- Fertility dynamics;
- Family structure evolution;
- Intergenerational relationships;
- Gender roles.

Description

- Computer-Assisted Web Interviewing (CAWI) & Computer-Assisted Personal Interviewing (CAPI).
- Longitudinal design tracks changes over time.
- Internationally comparable data.
- Specific modules added for Italy.

Features

- **Baseline GGS survey modules:** life history, fertility, household composition, generational relationships, well-being, work histories, income, and attitudes.
- **Additional modules for Italy:** parental leave, commuting life, transition to adulthood, and uncertainties.






Grafico 5.1 - Numero di bambini per cui la madre, il padre o entrambi i genitori hanno fruito di un congedo nell'anno


