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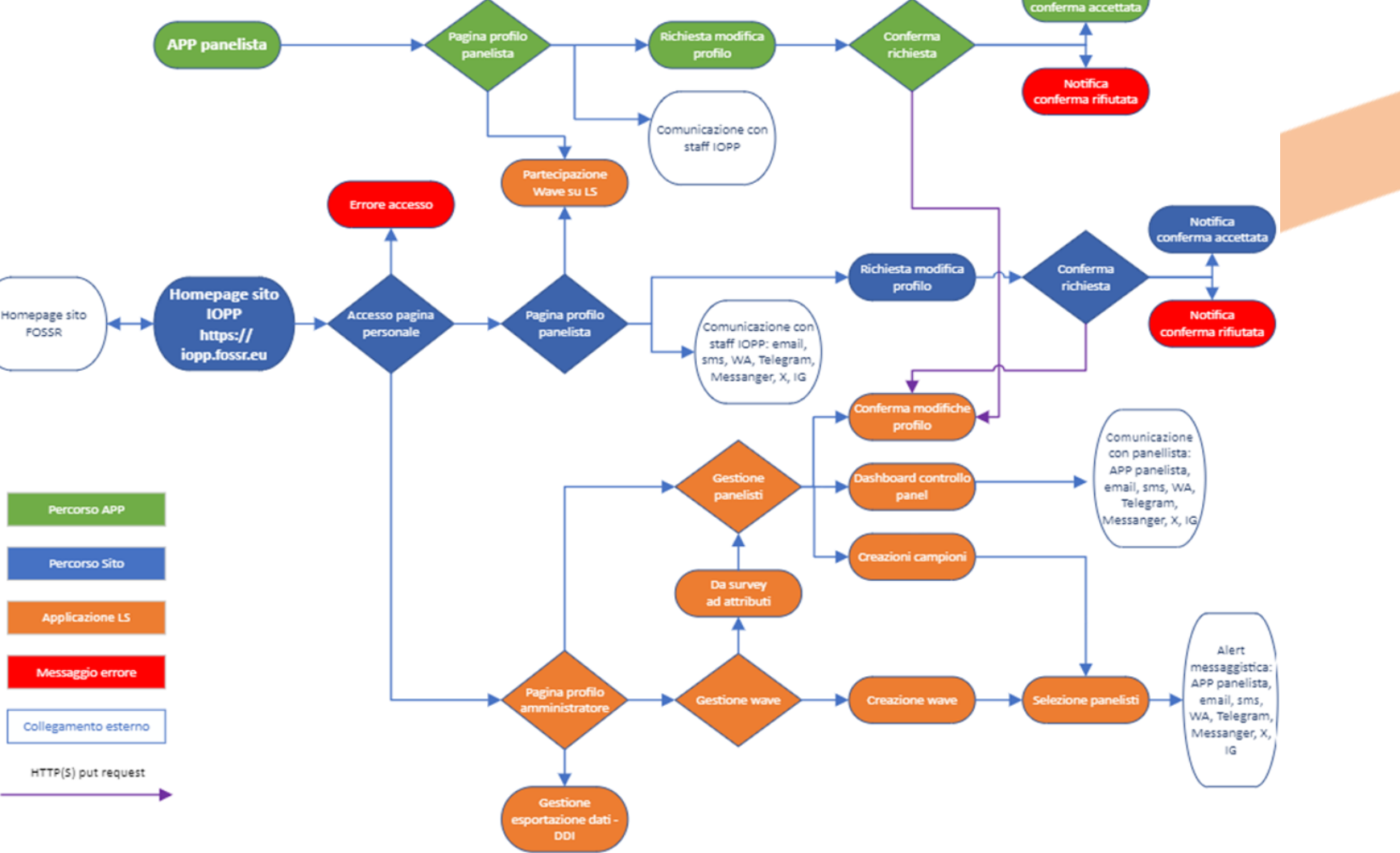
Description

IOPP is the first Online Probability Panel in Italy to generate longitudinal survey data to monitor social changes in Italy and to enhance FAIR and Open Data. Designed by CNR-IRPPS in collaboration with the University of Milan Statale, it will be a new social research infrastructure to collect data of the population 18-74 years old residing in Italy. It will comprise, each year, five waves featuring a core questionnaire plus rotating modules collected through periodic open calls addressed to scholars. The datasets provided will follow international classifications to allow comparability with other major European and international surveys. It is one venue of the CNR FOSSR project in the NextGeneration PNRR framework.

Key Objectives

- Start the first **ITALIAN ONLINE PROBABILITY PANEL (IOPP)**, aligning Italy to international experiences
- Provide social research with **prompt and high-quality longitudinal data** of demographic, social and economic dynamics on the Italian resident population.

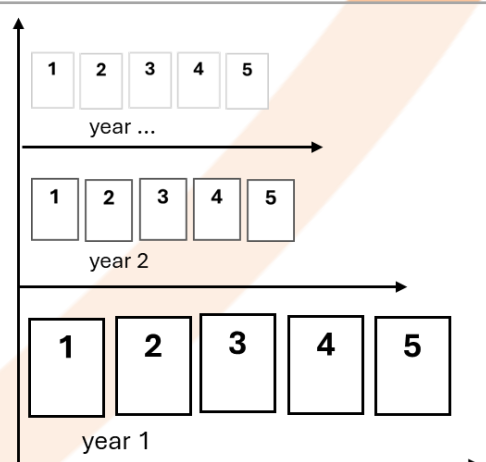

Objectives Recruitment of 10.000 Panellists

Next steps - the core of IOPP

5 waves per year

- FAIR and Open Data framework
Data stored, secured and accessible via FOSSR cloud service
- Accessibility to participants via multi-source: website, app, cawi
- Engagement and fidelity: participants can update life course events on their own profile
- **Core questionnaire → March 2025**
on subjects as family, housing, working life, income, vulnerability, inequality, poverty, social and political attitudes and values
- **Additional questionnaire for each wave → from 2026**
with rotating modules through periodic open calls addressed to scholars - open data accessibility



Conclusions

IOPP

- aims to be a collaborative tool for data collection in social sciences research
- will make available **up-to-date open datasets promptly in each wave** for the scientific community and stakeholders

Impact

- Aligning **Italy with international benchmarks** in the collection of data via Online Probability Panels
- Shortening data collection and accessibility for **immediate analysis** by the scientific community
- Integrating **innovative methods** to survey panels for data collection, storage and interoperability
