Museums Routes in Italy 2022

Road routes connecting the museums and similar institutions surveyed by the Istat 2022 survey form the museum routes here presented. Statistical information on cultural and tourism sites from official statistics or institutional sources enrich the routes

The adopted methodology was already tested on the data of the survey on Museums and similar institutions 2015 and 2018, and disseminated in the form of experimental statistics. A GIS procedure connects, the 107 starting museums, chosen as structures with the largest number of visitors in each Province/ UTS, to all other museums within a 30-minute drive. The road stretches through a set of municipal territories in which are located, in addition to other typical places of culture such as libraries and theaters, villages, protected natural areas, UNESCO sites. These territories are also characterized from the point of view of the tourists who visit them and the population that lives there, all potential users of museums and their natural and cultural heritage.

The proposed update also confirms that the routes are very different from each other: some are particularly rich in museums and other types of cultural assets, some concentrate in a single center, others are spread over many kilometers in the territory, beyond the boundaries of the Provinces/UTS and the reference regions. In some cases the paths overlap, in others they are isolated. Local public administrators, decision-makers, cultural, tourism entrepreneurs, and economic operators will find this integrated geographical vision a useful support for their work.

For each route, an attached summary card presents a number of indicators on the context, the type of museum and the tourist vocation of the route. In the technical note, there are useful information to read the attached cards. Annexes include a printing of the map of each route, including cultural and natural facilities on the territory. Routes are also downloadable as a geographical interchange file (shape file).

Results

This is the second update of the statistic on Museum Routes, the update follows that of the survey on Museums and similar institutions that happens every 3 years. The total number of route is not changed since the number of Province is the same as in 2018.

It is necessary to remember that in the time interval between the updates, the country faced the Covid-19 pandemic, which left its mark on many aspects of daily life and did not spare even the life of museums. Some museums were unable to reopen, while others reorganized during the closure, entered into agreements with other museums or institutions, rationalizing their exhibitions. Furthermore, the variation in the number of museums in the itineraries can also be attributed to the improvement of the survey's data and the closures for routine maintenance of some museum institutions. In 2022, the itineraries include 56 more museums, while fluctuations of length and museum number included are significant within them. It is also worth noting that changes in road infrastructure can affect the itineraries even in the absence of other variations, precisely because they are based on a 30-minute car journey; in fact, it seems that there has been

an enhancement of the road infrastructure during the intervening period. Overall, the 2022 itineraries are quite similar to those of 2018 based on the pre-Covid situation, although the differences are greater than one would expect in a normal update.

Table 1 shows the 107 itineraries ordered by the number of visitors and provides some information on the population, area, number of museums, and arrivals at tourist facilities in the underlying territory of the itinerary.

The analysis conducted by integrating various statistical sources shows that the routes with the highest number of tourist arrivals do not necessarily have the highest number of museum visitors, and vice versa. On the other hand, the data also show cases of itineraries where, despite a high number of tourist arrivals, there are few visitors to museum institutions.

Methodology

The Survey on museums and similar institutions is carried out within the framework of the "Memorandum of Understanding for the development of the integrated information system on cultural institutions and places", between Istat, the Ministry of Culture, Regions, and Autonomous Provinces, approved on 08.03.2023 by the State-Regions Conference, and in collaboration with the CEI - National Office for Ecclesiastical Cultural Heritage and Worship Buildings, which provided data on institutions of ecclesiastical entities collected annually as part of their institutional activities. From 2018 to 2023, the survey is conducted annually thanks to the agreement between Istat and the Managing Authority of the PON "Governance and Institutional Capacity 2014-2020", related to the implementation of the Project "Territorial and sectoral statistical information for cohesion policies 2014-2020" with Istat and the Department for Cohesion Policies (DPCoe) of the Presidency of the Council of Ministers and the Agency for Territorial Cohesion (ACT) as proposing entities.

The survey, conducted on a census basis, was carried out through the completion of an online questionnaire by the managers of each unit listed in the starting registry. It involved all public, state, non-state, and private institutions of various types and sizes that were open to the public in the year 2022. The results obtained provide an updated and detailed description of all museums, archaeological areas, monuments, and monumental complexes present in Italy and open with regulated and organized modes of access.

The survey delves into various themes. In addition to describing the structural characteristics of museum institutions, the types of preserved and exhibited assets, the legal nature and forms of management, the census also captures the access and visitation methods, the extent of owned assets, the employed personnel, financial resources and expenses incurred, visitor support, cultural activities, and services offered to the public. A specific module also allows for a deeper exploration of the inclusivity level of the facilities by investigating the types of structural and functional interventions adopted to accommodate visitors with disabilities, both motor and cognitive.

All results of the survey are published on Istat web site. The main figures are: in 2022, the Italian heritage can be quantified as consisting of 4,416 institutions spread throughout the national territory, capable of mobilizing a total of almost 108 million visitors. More than one in four Italian municipalities (27%) offer at least one structure, with approximately 2 museums per 100 square kilometers, and one museum for every 13,000 inhabitants.

Of the total number of museums surveyed, the majority consists of museums and collections of works and artifacts (3,392 in total): among these, the majority exhibit art collections (23.2%) and archaeological artifacts (15.9%), are thematic museums (13.1%), or display ethnographic and anthropological items of interest (13.4%). Monuments and monumental complexes (726 in total) consist of almost a third churches and religious buildings converted into museums (32.6%), fortified structures such as castles and towers (25.9%), or historical and artistic villas and palaces (22.5%). There is a significant presence of archaeological areas and parks throughout the territory (298 in total).

The "Survey on Museums and Similar Institutions" allowed, for the first time in 2015, to geolocate the objects identified through the control and standardization of addresses and the assignment of a pair of geographical coordinates to the museum's access point. The processes of geocoding and georeferencing have evolved in subsequent editions of the survey, and in parallel with the refinement of the registry, the knowledge of the location of the cultural objects surveyed has improved.

The references to the territory assigned to each structure include:

- The standardized address, possibly identified by the National Address Register. This process is assisted by commercial software (Egon owned by Ware Place srl) for recognition and normalization.
- The grid mesh of the regular European grid provided by EUROSTAT, defined in the reference system (EPSG: 3035) ETRS89/LAEA and transformed into WGS84/UTM32N.
- The coordinates of the access corresponding to the address in the WGS84 reference system projected in UTM32N. The georeferencing process, initiated during the 2016 survey, currently involves attributing coordinates to a point inside the perimeter of the museum. Some coordinates are automatically assigned during the normalization process, while missing coordinates are located on a map by an operator using recognition on orthophoto, Open Street Map, or Google Maps. In subsequent survey occasions, it was possible to verify and validate all automatic placements.
- The census section of the 2021 Provisional Territorial Bases in which the museum falls.

Georeferencing (assigning a pair of coordinates) and geocoding (assigning a reference whose geographic position is known, such as the municipality, address, etc.) allow for immediate comparison with territorial information from other sources at various levels of detail.

For each province, starting from the geographical coordinates of the most attractive museum in terms of annual number of visitors (main museum), all itineraries connecting it to other museums within a maximum driving time of 30 minutes have been defined, even in the presence of temporary traffic limitations (e.g., restricted traffic zones scheduled for specific time slots in some urban centers). Driving time is the best measure to define proximity or distance between locations as it takes into account various geographical features such as mountains, passes, rivers to cross, and lakes to circumnavigate, which simple kilometric distance cannot accurately represent. The road graph used to define the itineraries is based on the Tom-Tom road network in the 2023 version within the Network Analyst tool of ArcMap. This process allows for a representation of routes that align with the territorial reality regardless of administrative boundaries.

The choice of the starting point for the itineraries is a proposal to address the pressing question of how to decongest the most popular tourist destinations and the emergency of overtourism in many cities, in favor of a more sustainable and local tourism, through the redistribution of visitors and tourists to lesser-known but equally culturally interesting sites.

The methodology selected also allows for designing routes from any other point, using different means of transportation, over different distances. For example, it would be possible to design cycling routes around a farmhouse, walking routes starting from a parking lot, or train routes starting from airports or ports, as well as from the most popular tourist destinations, just to mention a few possibilities.

The routes are analyzed and characterized for their spatial aspects using GIS tools (e.g., the number of museums reachable, proximity to parks and natural areas). The geographies obtained are characterized by integrating the survey data on Museums with those available on an area basis at the minimum level of the municipality's location: libraries (Istat, Public reading libraries in Italy), theaters (revised SIAE data and georeferenced Istat), UNESCO sites (UNESCO), "Borgo" municipalities (The most beautiful villages in Italy, Orange flags of the Touring Club, and "Authentic Villages of Italy"), protected natural areas (MASE National Geoportal), tourism (Istat, Movement of clients in accommodation facilities), demography (Istat, Movement and calculation

of annual resident population). All the sources used provide georeferenced information, or at least geocoded at the municipal level.





Figure 1 - Museum routes in 2022: geography

In total, the 107 museum routes produced starting from the most visited museum in each Province are composed of a set of short routes, each connecting the main museum to every museum reachable within a 30-minute drive, which are then grouped together to form a route starting from a main museum. There are 2711 museum institutions located in the total number of itineraries, 889 of which are reached by more than one route as illustrated in Figure 2. The routes pass through 2,537 municipalities, which represent the geographical unit of analysis for the statistics presented in the attached sheets (Figure 1).

Each identified route is described by the characteristics of the museums visited, the presence or absence of libraries, theaters, parks, villages, UNESCO sites, and the potential user base (resident population and tourist arrivals). If we have the opportunity to use precise spatial information to characterize each of the itineraries (for example, the exact location of the museum, park, etc.), the same applies to the 107 routes, where data and indicators referring to the municipalities underlying them are used:

- Tourism (Istat, Movement of customers in accommodation facilities);
- Demography (Istat, Movement and calculation of annual resident population);
- UNESCO sites (Unesco);
- Villages (The most beautiful villages in Italy, Orange Flag villages, Authentic Villages of Italy);
- Protected natural areas (Geoportal MASE https://gn.mase.gov.it/portale/home).

Table 2 shows some information on the routes identified. There are 107 museum routes, corresponding to the 107 most visited museums in each province, from which it is possible to visit 2711 museums (61.4% of all Italian museums) through a network of itineraries within 30 minutes by car. Table 2 also shows a strong polarization in terms of visitors. In fact, the routes identified concentrate about one third of visitors (29.4%) in the 107 most visited museums and 88.9% in all the museums on the itineraries. The museums not reached by the routes are, instead, 1705, for a basin of little more than 12 million visitors, 11.1% of all the visitors of the Italian museums.

Each route has an average of 36 museums, but with extreme variability: from 1 to 136 institutes. This depends on several factors, including the cultural-historical identity, which is very varied in the country, the road networks and the morphology of the different territories. The latter influences the extension of the routes that can be made in 30 minutes by car and therefore the number of museums: The road network will be more developed and easier to use than those in mountainous areas.

Table 3 provides information on the types of museums included in the routes: among the most visited 52.3% are museums, 33.6% monuments or monumental complexes and 14% areas or archaeological parks, in line with national averages.

The legal form (table 4) does not seem to be characteristic for museums included in museum routes compared with those that are not part of them. The total number of institutions in the selected routes shows characteristics in line with national values, with 62.9% of public museums and 37.1% private ones. This correspondence, however, disappears when you look at the 107 most visited museums of the routes. The majority of public museums are included in the routes, with peaks of over 70% among the most visited museums.

In 2022 all routes insist on at least one protected natural area while 81.3% cross municipalities that have in their territory one or more "villages" and 62.2% common with UNESCO World Heritage sites (United Nations Educational, Scientific and Cultural Organization). 51.4% of the routes have all three characteristics (Table 5).
