EUROPEAN CONTEXT

In 2024, road fatalities within the EU27 decreased marginally to **20,017**, down from **20,466** in 2023 (–2.2%). When compared to the 2019 baseline, this represents a more significant reduction of **12.3**%, indicating continued progress toward long-term road safety targets

Significantly higher than average rates for young people and the elderly
