

Information on privacy and protection of personal data

(Article 13 of Regulation (EU) 2016/679)

The following information is provided pursuant to Article 13 of Regulation (EU) 2016/679 and aims to describe the methods of processing the personal data of participants in the public consultation organised for the celebration of Istat's 100 years anniversary.

Data Controller. The data controller is the National Institute of Statistics – Istat, with registered office at via Cesare Balbo no. 16, 00184 - Rome (PEC: protocollo@postacert.istat.it; switchboard: +39 06.46731).

Types of data processed and purposes of processing. The data collected through the questionnaire prepared for the consultation are used exclusively for the purposes thereof, as defined in the section of the Istat institutional website accessible at <https://www.istat.it/listituto/attivita/istat-100-contiamo-litalia-contiamo-per-il-futuro/consultazione-pubblica>. Contributions, observations, and proposals from respondents allow for the evaluation of how official statistics meet users' knowledge needs and requirements. Regarding personal and contact data (name, surname, email), their processing is aimed at sending, via email, confirmation of participation in the consultation and communications related to the outcomes of the initiative.

Legal basis. The data are processed for the performance of a task of public interest entrusted to Istat, with reference to the production and dissemination of official statistical information (Article 1, paragraph 2, and Article 15 of Legislative Decree No 322/1989), as well as to the promotion of user participation to improve statistical information (Article 4, paragraph 1, letter c) as per the Statute of the National Institute of Statistics, approved by the Institute's Council with Resolution No CDXLIV of 7 December 2017 and amended by Resolution No CDXCV of 13 December 2019).

Nature of the provision. The provision of data is necessary to participate in the public consultation.

Subjects who may process the data. The data are processed exclusively by formally authorised Istat personnel.

Dissemination of data. The data will be disseminated by Istat exclusively in aggregated form, so that it is not possible to identify the individuals who participated in the consultation.

Retention period. Personal data will be retained for no longer than 6 months from the close of the public consultation.

Data subject's rights and right to complain. To obtain access, correction, update, or deletion of personal data, restriction of their processing, or objection to it, the data subject may contact Istat's Data Protection Officer using the contact details provided above.

If you believe that the processing of personal data violates Regulation (EU) 2016/679, you also have the right to lodge a complaint with the Garante per la protezione dei dati personali or to seek appropriate legal remedies, as provided, respectively, by Article 77 and Article 79 of the Regulation itself.
